

RAF-grave at Fjerritslev Churchyard. SOE weapon flyer.

During a mission flying weapons to Danish Resistance at a dropping place in District I, Vendsyssel RAF weapon plane, Stirling LK312 crashed into the Limfjord at Livoe on the night before 5 March 1945. The whole crew was killed.

Pilot of the plane, leader of Squadron No. 161, Wing Commander Micael Andrew Brogan, DFC, Mentioned in Despatches, was found in the Limfjord on 12 May 1945. He was buried 15 may. A number of people from the Resistance in Northern Jutland were represented at the funeral.

The wireless operator of the plane, F/Lt. Harold Owen Sharman, DFC, was found in the Limfjord at Bygholm Vejler (Oesloes parish). He was buried on May 23th.

The other crewmembers are buried at Sejrsløv, Iceland of Mors (1) and at Loegstoer (4).
