Memorial stone 'The Hvidsten Group'. All eight members of this group were executed 29 June 1944. After the liberation the bodies were moved to Hvidsten and buried at this place.

The Memorial stone out at Allestrupgaard Forrest. RAF dropping place called 'Mustard Point' where the group from Hvidsten received weapon cargoes, picked up the containers, transported them on wagons and later on distributed the material to the Resistance Movement groups all over the country.
