

## Om AirmenDK

www.airmen.dk mindes allierede flyvere skudt ned over Danmark 1939-45. Næsten alle styrede ned i Danmark eller i havet omkring Danmark. Hvis en enkelt flyver nævnes hele besætningen.

Databasen indeholder 463 fly og 3.081 allierede flyvere. Under krigen blev Danmark overføjet omkring 40.000 gange af fly, der var på vej til eller fra bombardementer

over Tyskland eller mineudlæggning i danske farvande. De fleste af flyene over Danmark blev styret af Bomber Command, som havde et samlet tab på mere end 55.000 flyvere. Omkring 37.000 amerikanske flyvere fra baser i UK blev dræbt eller formodet døde.

## About AirmenDK

www.airmen.dk commemorates Allied airmen shot down over Denmark 1939 - 1945. Nearly all of them crashed in Denmark or in Danish waters. If one airman is known, all of the crew members are mentioned.

The database contains 463 planes and 3,081 Allied airmen. Allied planes flew over Denmark about 40,000 times on their way to and from bombing raids on Germany

or minelaying operations in Danish waters. Most of the planes over Denmark were controlled by Bomber Command which had a total loss of more than 55,000 airmen. About 37,000 American airmen from bases in the UK were killed or presumed killed.

## Besætning fra 5 nationer mindes hvert år i Aarestrup den 4. maj

Jeg har i dag tal talt med et medlem af menighedsrådet ved Aarestrup Kirke. Han fortæller at hvert eneste år den 4. maj om aftenen bliver der holdt en gudstjeneste i kirken i anledning af årsdagen for Anden Verdenskrigs slutning i Danmark, aftenen hvor tyskerne overgav sig.

Efter denne gudstjeneste bliver der først sat røde, hvide og blå blomster i våbenhuset ved en mindepæle for Svend Otto Nielsen, der blev henrettet af i 1944 af tyskerne, fordi han var meget aktiv i modstandsbevægelsen.

Han var son af skovfoged Nielsen. Det var ved skovfoged Nielsens kisterne med besætningen fra N/206 blev anbragt i dagene mellem de blev fundet i skoven og begravelsen 22. juni 1947.

Efterfølgende bliver der holdt en mindehøjtidelighed ved gravene. En person fra Aarestrup, udpeget af præsten, lægger først en krans på gravstedet.

Derefter bliver der holdt en kort mindetale og sunget en salme. En helt speciel salme, der ofte bliver benyttet ved begravelser (Altid frejdig når du går - Always dauntless when you tread -). That hymn is also connected to some events during WW2 in Denmark. After this ceremony a meeting is held in Aarestrup Village Hall. Here we sing a couple of hymns and have a cup of coffee or tea with some cake and a chat.



## Allierede flyvere begravet 124 steder Allied airmen buried in 124 places



The ceremony in Aarestrup Church has been held every year since 1945 in the evening of 4 May.

We do not know exactly when the tradition with a subsequent ceremony at the graves started, but we know with certainty that it has been held every year in the latest 48 years. Most likely the ceremony with wreathlaying and singing of the hymn has taken place every year since 1948.

The plot is kept and paid by Aarestrup Church. The headstones are kept by the Commonwealth War Graves Commission. The wreath placed at the plot on 4 May is paid by Aarestrup Church.

The plot is protected and is to be maintained in perpetuity.
