A fix showed it at 52°20'N/ 04°05'E off Dutch coast, but it was deemed '2nd Class' and possibly not reliable. Air Sea Rescue alerted but nothing found.					
	Hampden Mk. I, P1329 presumed crashed in sea off Dutch coast. No survivors.
