Last seen at 56°35'N/08°09'E at 0810 hrs. after attack on cargo vessel (1,500 tons) flying Nazi flag in Limfjord. Aircraft hit by flak. Starboard engine caught fire and aircraft crashed in flames on foreshore of Danish coast. After being hit it had climbed, turned to starboard, swaged out of control before crashing. Smoke mushroomed up to 100 ft. Aircraft patrolling were all of 'B' Flight, others returned safely.
