| | On 12 September 1941 at 01.45 hrs. Whitley V of No. 58 Sqdn. Serial Z6498 ditched onto Grønsund after being damaged by flak at Gedser Odde. Crew of five set floating aircraft on fire and were subsequently picked up by "K 12", a Danish police patrol boat. Afterwards taken into custody by the Germans. | | | | | |
