	Pellworm, Germany. All crew captured. 3 sea-mines recovered.					
	Another Manchester of squadron, L7391					
	was hit by light flak over Esbjerg wounding gunner and putting rear turret out of action.					
	Manchester Mk. I, L7399 on 3rd May at 0400 hrs. crash-landed S. of the road between Skrydstrup and Lilholt about one mile SE of Skrydstrup.					
	Five of crew killed, two survivors captured.					
	L7399 and R5840 were only losses for Bomber Command that night.
