		Stirling Mk. I, R9320 was hit by flak at Rødby and Kappel and crashed in Fehmarn Belt. 5 survivors in dinghy picked up by Danish fishing boat and later transferred to Danish minesweeper. Since the commander of the minesweeper insisted on handing over the airmen to Danish police only he was threatened forcibly by an Unteroffizier to comply with the German demand. The matter caused some strained relations between German and Danish authorities.
