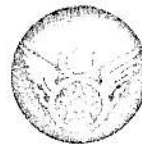

About ten descending parachutes observed. Body of airman by the name of Richard Wilkinson washed ashore between Fuglsang and Gottesgabe about 7 miles SSW of Nakskov, Laaland Island, Denmark. Opened parachute attached to body. More shots in back of the head.
