	Lancaster W4988 crashed at 0115 hrs. 4th Sep, near Laröd, Sweden. Aircraft disintegrated at 200 ft., wreckage spread over wide area.					
	Plt. Off. Greenway baled out over Germany and was captured. Flt. Sgt. Ward and Sgts. O'Brien and Johns all landed in Denmark. The first mentioned were taken prisoners by the Germans but Sgt. Johns managed to escape to Sweden. Flt. Sgt. Conway drowned
