Sgt. R.E. Toomey: Took part in raid day before. Normal day after sleep. Briefing for Brunswick which was scrubbed, no reason given. Assigned Stettin.	Returning from Stettin over Denmark Lancaster KB751 was at 0220 hrs. on 17th August attacked by nightfighter. Lancaster exploded in mid air and crashed in sea two nautical miles SW of Sejerø Harbour, Sejerø Island.					
Altitude: 18,000 feet, weather cloudy, 8/10 broken.	In spite of considerable distance to land, heavy sea and rapid current, Sgt. Toomey, only survivor, managed to reach shore at Lydebjerg, Sejerø Island after several hours in the water. First aid given to Sgt. Toomey by Aksel and Karen Jensen at Lydebjerg. POW subsequently.
