Lancaster NE144 attacked by night fighter and greatly damaged. Flg. Off. Humphris ditched aircraft in Kattegat 2 nautical miles north of Anholt Harbour, Anholt Island. Lancaster broke in two and 3 of crew went down with the tail. 4 from crew picked up by Danish lifeboat at Anholt and captured by the Germans eventually.						
Aircraft had jettisoned bombload before ditching.
