Reported landing in neutral country.						
Wg. Cdr. F.H. Denton in PZ402 "A" damaged by flak. Starboard flap shot away and hydraulics U/S. Made belly landing on return without any injures.						
Mosquito NT123 hit by flak at Copenhagen and carried on in attempt to reach Sweden. Aircraft crashed, however, in the Sound off Hakens Lighthouse on the east coast of Ven Is., Sweden. The aircraft floated for two minutes before it went down. Airman in dinghy seen, but high wind and sea prevented from rescue.						
Flt. Lt. R.J. Dempsey in PZ462 "J" had an engine hit and flew home 400 miles on one engine. 2 others slightly damaged.
