Subject: Orders.

1. a. The following officers, escaped from enemy occupied territory are assigned to temp duty this station while awaiting transportation to ----- . They will proceed on first available air transportation to ----- and then proceed without delay via air or rail transportation from point of landing to ----- reporting on arrival to United States Army Special Reception Center, -----.

b. TDN 1-5600 P 431-01, 02, 03, 07, 08 A 0425-24. Travel by military, naval or commercial aircraft, Army or Naval transport, commercial steamship, belligerent vessel or aircraft and rail is directed. Travel by air from ----- to ----- is necessary for the accomplishment of an emergency war mission.

c. In lieu of subsistence, a flat per diem of six dollars (\$6.00) is authorized in accordance with existing law and regulations while traveling in pursuance of these orders and for period of temporary duty at ----- . A baggage allowance of fifty-five (55) lbs., to include all personal effects, is authorized while traveling by military, naval or commercial aircraft.

b. Travel by military, naval or commercial aircraft (Par 3, AR 55-120 1943) is directed as necessary in the performance of an emergency war mission. Travel by Army or Naval transport, commercial steamship, belligerent vessel or aircraft, and rail is authorized. A flat per diem of six dollars (\$6.00) is authorized while traveling by air and for periods of detention while in a travel by air status.

c. A baggage allowance of fifty-five (55) pounds is authorized while traveling by military, naval or commercial aircraft.

d. In accordance with Section II of Executive Order 9386 as published in Section II, Bulletin No. 19 WD 21 Oct 43, the Finance Department will pay these enlisted men monetary allowances in lieu of rations while traveling other than by air and monetary allowances in lieu of rations and quarters for periods of detention while traveling other than by air.
